

Notification from: **Santa Lucia Preserve**

IMPORTANT COVID-19 Update

Dear Preserve Community,

While we await the second round of test results of our Food and Beverage staff, management has been alerted that an employee in the Grounds and Greens department has tested positive for the virus. The employee, who does not interact directly with Members, was not feeling well on Wednesday, July 15th, which was the last day he worked. Management appropriately asked the employee to be tested, and today, positive test results were received. This employee has been home in quarantine since Thursday, July 16th, and is feeling much better.

In an abundance of caution, all Grounds and Greens staff having “close contact” as defined by the CDC for essential workers, will be required to test for the virus and receive a negative result before returning. As we learn more, the Golf management team will provide further information on the impacts this may have on the fraze mowing project and impending course closure.

As required by the Americans with Disabilities Act, we are precluded from providing any additional information about this case. As we are all aware, the national, state and local situation is rapidly evolving each day, and our county is currently experiencing active community transmission of the virus.

The Emergency Operations Committee is prepared with protocols in place to handle arising situations related to COVID-19 and will communicate with you as updates become available.
